Entrance requirements:

- Must have a program GPA of 2.75 or greater.
- Admission to each program is limited.
- Signed permission of the Head of the Department and the Director-SRMK is required for admission.

Course/Program Requirements:

- Each minor will require minimum number of credits. More credit hours than this may be taken but only with the permission of the Department Head and School Director.
- For the **BA (Psychology) with minor in KINE**: **BA (Psychology) with minor in RECR**: students will complete 24hrs of electives; **BSc (Psychology) with minor in KINE**; or **BSc (Psychology) with minor in RECR**: students will complete 18hrs of electives.
